

AUTOHELLAS HERTZ REPORTS INCREASED TURNOVER FOR THE FIRST SEMESTER OF 2007

An increase in turnover reported Autohellas–Hertz for the second quarter of 2007. Consolidated turnover reached €55.8m Euro from €50.8m in last year's semester, an increase of 9.8%. Consolidated earning after tax and minority rights reached €4.4m from €3.7m in 2006.

The listing of Aegean Airlines in the Athens Stock exchange market has resulted in a revaluation of Autohellas's participation in Aegean, thus increasing the company's net worth to €138.7m from €115.m on 31/12/2006.

It is worth mentioning that Autotechnica Fleet Services S.R.L., a Romanian based company operating in the Fleet Management sector, has been consolidated for the first time in the second quarter financial statements.

Parent company reported a turnover of €51.2m from €47.2m, an increase of 8.5% from last year's semester, with earnings after tax reaching €4.1m from €4.6m in 2006.
