

CVs OF MEMBERS OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF AUTOHELLAS

EMMANOUELA VASSILAKIS

Emmanouela Vassilaki, jointly with Theodore Vassilakis, are the co-founders of the Company and the Autohellas Group, from its origins in Heraklion Crete, where initially started with 6 only vehicles.

Mrs. Vassilaki's entire carrier of the last 55 years was dedicated exclusively to the car rental industry and the management of Autohellas, thus having unique experience and knowledge in this area. She has been an executive board member of Autohellas since its listing in 1999 as well as its General Manager.

Mrs. Vassilaki is Chairwoman of the Board of Directors since May 2018.

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MARINOS YANNOPOULOS

Marinos Giannopoulos graduated from the Athens College and studied Economics (B.A.) at the American College of Greece (Deree College), Industrial Economics (M.A.) at the University of Sussex in the United Kingdom and Business Administration (M.B.A.) at the University of Manchester (Manchester Business School) in the United Kingdom.

He commenced his career as internal auditor, working for Exxon in London, Rome and Athens during 1978 and 1982. From 1982 he worked for ten years for Chase Manhattan Bank, in the Treasury Department in New York and then in Milan and Frankfurt as Country Capital Markets Executive and Treasurer.

He was Executive Director, General Manager and CFO of Alpha Bank as well as Deputy CEO of Chipita S.A. He was also appointed Vice Chairman of the Board of Directors of Hellenic Bank in Cyprus. Today, he is Managing Partner of X-PM Consulting and Member of the Board Directors of the company Potopoiia Plomariou.

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EFTICHIOS VASSILAKIS

Mr. Eftichios Vassilakis is CEO of Autohellas and Chairman of Aegean and Olympic Air, while he also serves on the Board of Directors of other non-listed affiliated companies.

He was a non-executive member of the Board of FOURLIS SA Holdings from 2005 until February 2022, as well as its subsidiary HOUSEMARKET SA from 2016 to July 2021. Mr. Vassilakis holds non-executive directorships with Lamda Development and luxury resorts developer TEMES. He previously served as a non-executive board member with Piraeus Bank and Titan Cement.

Since 2011, he has been a Board member of the Association of Greek Tourism Enterprises and Vice Chairman since 2014. He is also a Board Member and member of the executive committee of the Hellenic Federation of Enterprises (SEV). Since 2017, he is a Board member of Endeavor Greece.

He is also a Board member and one of the founding partners of «Marketing Greece» as well as the consortium for the promotion of Athens «This is Athens».

Mr. Vassilakis holds a B.A. in Economics from Yale University (1988) and an MBA from the Columbia Business School of New York (1991).

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GEORGE VASSILAKIS

George Vassilakis studied Modern History and Business Administration at the Georgetown University of Washington DC. Following graduation and completion of his military obligations, he worked for a year in Spain. When he returned to Greece he worked for the AUTOHELLAS Group at the SAAB Importing Company and during the next ten years he gradually undertook the monitoring of the automotive distribution activities of the AUTOHELLAS Group.

These include AUTOTECHNICA / VELMAR, distributor and repairer for 12 automotive brands, as well as of the importers HYUNDAI HELLAS, KIA HELLAS and TECHNOCAR (SEAT). He is a member of the Board of Directors of AUTOHELLAS, AEGEAN and PHAEA RESORTS.

Mr. Vassilakis is a member of the Board of Directors of the Hellenic Association of Motor Vehicle Importers and Representatives, in which he is President for 14 years now.

KONSTANTINOS DELIGIANNIS

Konstantinos Deligiannis joined Autohellas in September 2023 and assumed the duties of Deputy CEO.

He has thirty years of experience in the market of consumer products and services, in Greece and abroad. He started his career at United Distillers Boutaris and Neoset in operations and supply chain roles in the five years 1992-1997. He followed an eleven-year career at Info Quest Technologies, as Operations and Commercial Director. In 2008 he joined the Olympia Group as Chief Operating Officer of the companies Public and Multirama. This was followed by an eleven-year tenure at Amazon.com in Luxembourg (2012-2023), with three different positions of responsibility for Amazon's European consumer business.

He studied Mechanical Engineering with a minor in Economics at Tufts University (Massachusetts, USA) and holds a Master in industrial Robotics and Manufacturing Automation from Imperial College (London, UK).

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LIZA (GARYFALLIA) PELEKANOU

Liza (Garyfallia) Pelekanou in 1988 graduated from the Department of Business Administration of the University of Piraeus (ranked 1st in class). Kostas Sfakakis is a graduate of the Athens University of Economics and Business (AUEB), Department of Business Administration.

He began his professional career abroad in 1976 with the auditing firm Peat, Marwick, Mitchell & Co. Subsequently (1977–1981), he worked in Greece in the Finance and Accounting Departments of Bristol-Myers International Corporation and Johnson & Johnson Hellas.

From 1982 to 2008, he worked at Coca-Cola Hellenic Bottling Company (CCHBC Greece S.A.I.C.) as Finance Director for Greece and Corporate Finance & External Relations Director, while also participating in the Group's Mergers & Acquisitions team.

Since 2010, he has been serving as Advisor to the Board on tax policy matters at the Hellenic Federation of Enterprises (SEV) and as Coordinator of SEV's Tax Committee.

He is also a Board Member, and Chairman or Member of Audit Committees, of listed companies. He is a member of the Tax Committee of the American-Hellenic Chamber of Commerce, the International Fiscal Association (IFA), and the Economic Chamber of Greece.
